

Gelatin Fairy

Gelatin Prep:

- Prepare gelatin using 1:2 ½ ratio (gelatin:water)
- Divide, then add desired color to paint:
 - daisy petals for base flower
 - fairy wings of choice
 - flower petals for skirt
- Let these sheets dry.

- Use gumpaste to form body parts with the fairy mold.
- Break a piece of styrofoam to use as the rock base.



- Glue body, head and legs together using gum glue.
- **DON'T GLUE ARMS** on yet.
- Position on foam (rock).
- Create bra using gumpaste or gelatin, and attach with piping gel.



- Trim gelatin flower petals for skirt.
- Attach around waist using piping gel as glue.



- * If disco dust is desired on skirt petal edges, add this before attaching petals.
- Brush thin layer of piping gel where disco dust is desired, then dip in dust and tap excess off.
- Allow to dry before attaching.



- Cover the foam piece (rock) with marbled fondant, using piping gel as glue.
- Add smaller balls of fondant (additional rocks) around base if desired.



- Trim gelatin daisy petals for flower base.
- Add gumpaste center in desired color, attaching to rock base with piping gel.
- Attach flower petals using piping gel.



- Continue adding daisy petals until desired fullness is reached.



- ### Finishing Touches:
- Glue (using piping gel) on the arms.
 - Add hair using a clay gun.
 - Paint on facial features, or use edible markers to draw them on.



- Glue fairy in place on rock base using piping gel.
- Attach wings to back using piping gel.
- Add any desired additional finishing touches (such as tiny flower in hair or as bracelet, etc.)
